Our mission is to maintain hope, faith and compassion in the lives of MPRI patients and their caregivers.

**The Hoosier Hospitality Ministry** was organized by Phil Thompson in 2005. Phil is a retiree of the Indiana University Cyclotron facility, and has completed proton radiation therapy himself. He discovered the housing needs of patients traveling to Bloomington during his care and treatment at MPRI. Working hand-in-hand with SOCC and MPRI, Phil created this ministry to ease the difficulty in finding temporary lodging, and to offer encouragement.

**The Hoosier Hospitality ministry** operates five residences presently. Our new vision includes adding more homes to meet the growing needs of patients coming to Bloomington for proton treatment at the Midwest Proton Radiotherapy Institute.

**We invite our guests** to participate in Sunday Worship and Wednesday night dinner, but do not make this a requirement. We encourage the camaraderie and fellowship of patients staying in the Hoosier Hospitality homes. We offer friendship, laughter and genuine concern to all our guests and their families.
